TNISGCRC study

ISG – TN chapter recently completed the largest prospective multi-centre study of newly diagnosed colorectal cancer from India by recruiting 1,208 patients across 23 centres in Tamil Nadu between 2021 and 2022.

The key results are as follows:

- Tamils constituted 81.9% of the study population
- 78.6% belonged to poorer socio-economic classes (III-V).
- The predominant symptoms suggested left sided disease with the majority of the cancers (63.5%) being located within the reach of the flexible sigmoidoscope.
- On presentation, most patients (65.6%) exceeded stage 2 disease.

We hope that the results of this study will help in designing strategies to improve prevention and management of colorectal cancer in our state.
